History of the Akron Crime Clinic

Doug Jenney gave an excellent presentation on the history of the Akron Crime Clinic at our last meeting. The original organization was an off-shoot of the Cleveland Crime Clinic and consisted mainly of Railroad Police Officers. Their first meeting was on October 15, 1937 and was held at the Mayflower Hotel. The dues were three dollars per year.

In 1940 the Akron Crime Clinic was incorporated and our organization was chartered by the State in 1941. During World War II the Akron Crime Clinic was involved in civil defense. October of 1962 marked the twenty-fifth anniversary and the guest speaker was the second in command of the FBI.
